Question to DSA: We have an old admin/class room building built in the 40s that have viridovs that are inneed of replacement. One option we're looking at is to utilize the COVID relief fund to convert these windows so they are operable thus improve the ventilation/indoor air quality. We envision the upper 1/3 or 1/4 of the window to be either awning or hopper windows. If we do so, then how do we address accessibility requirement?

<u>DSA Response</u> Yes, a minimum of one windowin each room that has new operable windows must comply with 11B 229. Which requires the operating mechanism or controls to be within reach requirements of 11B 305 for clear floor space, 11B 308 for reach requirements and 11B 3094 for the operation of the mechanism or control.

Inaddition to that, the windowseplacement that includes both frame and glazing will trigger 11B 2024 and the 'Path of Travel' requirements. Glazing alone will not trigger 11B 2024
