Hello CJUSD families,

As many of you have already heard, Governor Newsom announced last week that he plans to add the COVID-19 vaccine to the list of vaccinations required to attend in-person school in the state of California once the vaccine receives full approval from the Food and Drug Administration.

The Colton Joint Unified School District is following this announcement closely. The information released by the governor indicates that the California Department of Public Health will consider recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the United States Department of Health and Human Services, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the American Academy of Family Physicians before implementing a requirement. You can read more about [Governor Newsom's announcement here](#). The targeted timeline is either January 1 or July 1, 2022. It would be implemented by grade span, first 7-12 and then K-6 pending vaccine approval for those age groups.

There are a lot of questions that remain unanswered. We have relied upon and followed the CDPH's guidance throughout the pandemic as our roadmap to keeping our students and staff as safe as possible and will continue to do so. We will continue to provide updates once the
